
Evidence of your finances for STUDENT ROUTE visa applications



As part of your visa application the UKVI will assess whether you have sufficient funds to study in the UK. Your visa application must demonstrate that you have either money for boarding fees or sufficient tuition fees and maintenance funds (for living costs) for the first year of your course, less any fees paid already to the school.



Example 1

You have applied for a 2-year A Level course and have requested school accommodation.

Boarding Fees (course + accommodation)

£29,985 + £19,995 = £49,980

Fees Paid

£2,500

You are required to show

£49,980 - £2,500 = £47,480

Example 2

You have applied for a 2-year A Level course and staying in independent (not school) accommodation.

Course Fees

£29,985

Maintenance Funds

£1,136 x 9 months = £10,224

Fees Paid

£2,500

You are required to show

(£29,985 + £10,224) - £2,500 = £37,709
