CSVPA China offers art and design, drama and music courses to Chinese and foreign national students at Grades 10 and 11.


The CSVPA China model is 2+1 for Art and Design courses and 2+2 for Drama and Music courses.

Students spend two years studying in China followed by a year (two years for music students) at CSVPA in Cambridge or CATS Academy Boston.




